All participants receive written comments and a medal (Bronze, Silver or Gold). Gold Medal winners are invited to perform again later in a formal concert, free and open to the public. Quite a few of the festival's medalists have gone on to successful musical careers while all appreciate the joy of making music for the rest of their lives.

We can take pride in the Milton Young Musicians Festival and in continuing its worthy tradition of nurturing the musical passions and talents of our youth. This year the festival is open to students of all ages and in all grades 1 – 12. Last year we rolled the Elementary Festival into the Young Musicians Festival and it was very successful. Students perform solos and scales for professional musicians who in return critique, comment, and encourage them as well as take the opportunity to converse musically in an individual setting.

In the past the festivals have received support from the Milton Cultural Council, a local agency of the Massachusetts Cultural Council, the Milton Junior Women's Club, as well as private donations. **The continuation of this fine program depends heavily on contributions by individuals like you, so we are asking for your support.**
